## Troparia and Kontakia

*Troparion, Tone 5:* Let us the faithful acclaim and worship the Word,\* co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit,\* and born of the Virgin for our salvation.\* For He willed to be lifted up on the cross in the flesh, to suffer death\* and to raise the dead by His glorious resurrection.

*Troparion, Tone 8:* O saints, your message has spread throughout the world\* for receiving the Spirit in tongues of fire you torched the idols' deceit.\* With the net of your words you caught those who were lost and brought them to faith.\* Therefore the heavens declare your glory\* and the firmament which God created adds its voice\* and we with them cry out feasting your memory.\* Save us all, O God, by the prayer of your twelve apostles.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

*Kontakion, Tone 5:* You, my Saviour, descended to Hades,\* and as the Almighty, You shattered its gates.\* With Yourself You, as the Creator, raised the dead and shattered the sting of death,\* and delivered Adam from the curse, O Lover of Mankind.\* And so we cry out: "Save us, O Lord."

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

*Kontakion, Tone 2:* Christ the Rock today valiantly glorifies the rock of faith,\* the most splendid of the disciples, along with Paul and the council of the twelve.\* As we celebrate their memory with faith we glorify the One who glorified them.

### Prokeimenon, Tone 5

You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us\* from this generation and for ever. *verse:* Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man. (Psalm 11:8,2)

### Prokeimenon, Tone 8

Their utterance has gone forth into all the earth, and their word unto the ends of the world. *verse:* The heavens tell the glory of God, and the firmament declares the work of His hands. (Psalm 18:5,2)

### Alleluia, Tone 5

*verse:* Your mercies, O Lord, I will sing for ever; from generation to generation I will announce Your truth with my mouth.

*verse:* The heavens shall confess our wonders, O Lord, and Your truth in the church of the saints. *verse:* God is glorified in the assembly of the saints. (Psalm 88:6,8)
